Department of Education

Title: PE, school sport and physical activity research and evaluation programme

Value: up to £350,000

Description: The requirement is a research and evaluation programme comprised of two projects: 1) primary PE and school sport research and evaluation; 2) secondary PE and school sport research. The overarching aim of the programme is to fill strategic evidence gaps in relation to PE, school sport and physical activity at primary and secondary schools, including conducting evaluations of key programmes.

We envisage that both projects will involve qualitative and quantitative methods, such as case studies and depth interviews, and large-scale survey development and analysi respectively.

As this is a complex, multi-strand research and evaluation programme, we anticipate consortia being formed in order to best meet the requirement and encourage interested suppliers to begin engaging with one another.
